Parents in the Lead activities fund enables parents, expectant parents and grandparents to run their own activities with their 0-4 year olds in BD3, BD4 and BD5.

The majority of those benefiting from this fund must be families expecting babies or children under four and their parents in the Better Start Bradford area.

There is a quick, simple application form which parents complete to tell us about your ideas and what these will cost. We are particularly interested to hear from parents who are not currently involved in local activities for babies and children, to support them to get involved.

Crafty Kids

Crafty Kids received £1,429 to run a series of monthly family learning activity sessions including: wheelbarrow making, creating fairy gardens, puppet making, cook and eat sessions and circus skills. The creative activities were designed to help kick-start the children's education by supporting the learning delivered in school.



Killinghall Parents

Killinghall Parents and Friends Association received £699 to create a safe outdoor environment for the toddler group. Thanks to the funding, parents/carers and toddlers have had fun planting, growing and learning about food and have been encouraged to grow vegetables at home too!


