We would cover costs only and the application would need to make the nature of the relationship, responsibilities and costs very clear.
Are there any male facilitators of HENRY? Do we have a job title for the post? What will the salary be? Can we advertise roles as a job share if successful? Yes in a supporting role. We want to support community organisations to undertake engagement work with families. Family Hubs/ children's centres nurseries and schools that are maintained by the local authority may be a partner where this enables the community organisation to do the engagement work, for example by providing premises or taking on an employer role but we would not expect these organisations to be undertaking any of the proposed activities. All roles, responsibilities and the nature of the relationship should be made very clear, for example if the support offered is to be paid for or not and the costs attached.
